

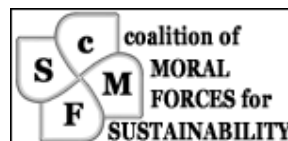

5. The government is responsible for ensuring the rights of all its citizens—especially the marginal members in rural communities—and to help secure the fulfillment of these rights.
